The days of the week in Spanish — print me and put me where breakfast happens.

ESPAÑOL	SAY IT	ENGLISH	MEMORY HOOK
lunes	LOO-nés	Monday	la Luna — the Moon
martes	MAR-tes	Tuesday	Marte — Mars
miércoles	MYER-ko-les	Wednesday	Mercurio — Mercury
jueves	HWE-ves	Thursday	Júpiter — Jupiter
viernes	VYER-nés	Friday	Venus
sábado	SAH-ba-do	Saturday	the Sabbath
domingo	do-MEEN-go	Sunday	"day of the Lord"

The week starts on Monday

Spanish calendars begin with lunes, not Sunday — that's why the chart starts there.

Never capitalized

Days of the week are lowercase in Spanish, even in the middle of a sentence: *Hoy es lunes.*

The weekend

sábado + domingo = *el fin de semana*. Green rows on this chart.

—¿Vos sabés qué día es hoy? —¡Sí! Hoy es ____.

Ask it every morning at breakfast. (In Argentina, where Profé's family is from, we say *vos* instead of *tú* — same beautiful Spanish.)
